Continue to Pray for our Council Sponsored Seminarians

Our Sealy KC Council 3313 and Immaculate Conception Church is honored with one of our own, Andres Morin, who left Sealy on Sunday, August 30, heading to Florence, Italy, to join the Seminary of the Institute of Christ the King Sovereign Priest. Brother Andres had spent the previous year in Wausau, Wisconsin, in a pre-seminary program for the Order at their St. Mary's Oratory.

(KC) Brother Morin recently shared in a letter sending his greetings to us and he was aware of our encounter with the Feb. ice storm. He noted that upon completion of their first trimester of the academic year they enjoyed an outing in the area and were also able to enjoy snow along with a snowball fight.

Brother Morin is taking his course in French. In Nov., following the Feast of All Saints, they took a 2-week break from courses to harvest nearly 2,000 olive trees that surround the seminary. Andrea noted they collected a record number of olives and olive oil which coincided with the seminary's 30th Anniversary. A familiar name to Americans, His Eminence Cardinal Raymond L. Burke now stationed in Rome visited during the Christmas season and was the Celebrant for holiday liturgies.

After the Xmas Holiday's, Andre resumed his studies including History of Christian Spirituality, Doctrine, Fundamental Methodology, the Psalms,

Latin, Introduction to Sacred Scripture, Introduction to Pontifical Texts, Gregorian Chant, Introduction to Philosophy and Introduction to the Liturgy. Brother Morin was relieved that he had passed his exams.

So let's continue to make an extra effort to offer prayers for our Brother Knight Andres Morin for a successful journey towards priesthood, some years away.
