## **GUIDELINES**

Sealy Father Crann Knights of Columbus Council No. 3313 is offering grants in the cumulative total of \$2,500 (two thousand five hundred dollars) to applicants based upon need and merit. The dollar amount of each scholarship grant is \$500 (five hundred dollars).

- 1. Applicant must meet all qualifications for entry into and be accepted by an institution of higher learning referenced in Guideline No. 2. In addition, applicant, parent/guardian, and/or grandparent must satisfy the required amount of points of KC service during the period of July 1, 2021 through April 1, 2022.
- 2. Scholarship funds are to be used to pay for education in a university, college, junior college, technical school, business school, or seminary of the applicant's choice.
- 3. Applicant must be a Knight of Columbus in good standing or the wife, son, or daughter of a member in good standing in Council No. 3313. Dependents of deceased members are also eligible.
- 4. Applicant must be a candidate for graduation from high school for the current year.
- 5. Special emphasis will be given to "the personal reason for applying" statement on the front side of this application.
- 6. Successful applicants are to be selected by the Aid to Education Committee and will be so announced at the high school scholarship ceremony.
- 7. Scholarship funds are to be paid to a successful applicant upon written receipt of the first semester transcript from the institution of higher learning referenced in Guideline No. 2.
- 8. Application must be submitted to any member of the Aid to Education Committee (listed below) on or before April 1, 2022.
