GUIDELINES

Sealy Father Crann Knights of Columbus Council No. 3313 is offering grants in the cumulative total of \$2,500 (two thousand five hundred dollars) to applicants based upon need and merit. The dollar amount of each scholarship grant is \$500 (five hundred dollars).

1. Applicant must meet all qualifications for entry into and be accepted by an institution of higher learning referenced in Guideline No. 2. In addition, applicant, parent/guardian, and/or grandparent must satisfy the required number of points of KC service during the period of July 1, 2023 through April 1, 2024.
2. Scholarship funds are to be used to pay for education in a university, college, junior college, technical school, business school, or seminary of the applicant’s choice.
3. Applicant must be a Knight of Columbus in good standing or the wife, son, or daughter of a member in good standing in Council No. 3313. Dependents of deceased members are also eligible.
4. Applicant must be a candidate for graduation from high school for the current year.
5. Special emphasis will be given to “the personal reason for applying” statement on the front side of this application.
6. Successful applicants are to be selected by the Aid to Education Committee and will be announced at the high school scholarship ceremony.
7. Scholarship funds are to be paid to a successful applicant upon written receipt of the first semester transcript from the institution of higher learning referenced in Guideline No. 2.
8. Application must be submitted to any member of the Aid to Education Committee (listed below) on or before April 1, 2024.
