KC Scholarships



This year we awarded 2 scholarships to Brooke Kram (daughter of Brother Jon and Angie Kram) and to Ally Dickens (daughter of Brother Gary and Lisa Dickens). For the year of 2021-2022, our KC Council will once again have scholarships available for the sons and daughters of Brother Knights who will be graduating from high school in 2022.

In order to qualify for a Sealy KC scholarship, the applicant, mother, and/or father must obtain 20 points during the time period beginning July 1, 2021 through April 1, 2022. We have completed the transition for bank signatories and PO box access. Recently Brilliant Energy, the previous energy provider for the hall filed for bankruptcy. We were able to sign a new three-year contract at a reasonable rate and avoided major increases to the power bill.
